	<p>Mrs. Gimlin shared the following information with the board:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• H.S. &amp; J.H. volleyball is going well.</li> <li>• All high school students will be taking the ASVAB test. The test will be able to replace State tests requirements if passed.</li> <li>• The new guidelines for 3 foot distancing is for student to student and not for adults. We are able to have 50% capacity in the gym with 6 feet distancing between people.</li> <li>• Since we are not a Title I school, the E.S.S.E.R. funds will be distributed differently for our district. We should be entitled to \$1,500 per student.</li> <li>• Track starts next week and the high school will be having meets.</li> <li>• Basketball season will start on May 10<sup>th</sup> and ends on June</li> </ul>	Superintendent’s Report
