She thoroughly enjoyed the conference and even had the chance to speak with Superintendent Chris Reykdal about the challenges we face in Glenwood. She also discussed mental health concerns for students and teachers and shared that we are a leading school in the outdoor education program. • Next year our district will need to implement “Breakfast After the Bell”, the program provides the opportunity for students to receive a meal even if they are late to school. Ms. Mengarelli will be working with Mrs. Troh and Mrs. Thomas on implementing this meal program. Ms. Mengarelli feels as though this isn’t a big issue here at Glenwood School, most students arrive in time to have breakfast before school. • Ms. Mengarelli is performing final evaluations for our teachers.
